GIFT A TREE

The Prospect Heights Park District Tree of Life Planting Program has been created to offer individuals, friends, organizations and companies the opportunity to recognize a person, event or a special organization. A tree is lasting and will grow with the community for generations to come. If you would like to honor someone, why not have a tree planted at one of the District's fourteen sites?

As part of your gift, an inscribed gold leaf will be part of the Tree of Life display, located in the lobby area of the Gary Morava Recreation Center located at 110 West Camp McDonald Road in Prospect Heights.

HOW TO SELECT THE PERFECT TREE

When choosing a tree, remember there are a variety of choices. We are interested in finding the most suitable tree for your gift. Once you choose a particular park, staff will assist you with the tree location and selection.

VARIETY OF TREES

Listed within this brochure are a few recommended trees for planting. All species require specific ecological conditions. Specific trees have been chosen because they best suit the planting environment of selected parks. Any special request can be discussed with the Superintendent of Parks and Facilities who will try to accommodate your request.

THE PROCESS

Contact the Superintendent of Parks and Facilities at 847-394-2848 to schedule an appointment. The Superintendent will ask if there are preferences of park location and tree selection. An acknowledgment letter will be mailed to the family of the person or organization being honored, if you would like. After the tree is planted, you will be notified by District staff.

We accept requests to gift trees year-round; however, depending on the type of tree, planting only takes place during the spring and fall of each year,. Each tree will be maintained in accordance with the District's tree maintenance program.

COST OF TREE

The cost varies according to size and type of tree you select and range between \$375 -\$575 which includes the tree purchase, its installation and the leaf on display at the Gary Morava Recreation Center. The Prospect Heights Park District will be responsible, if it becomes necessary, for replacing any gifted trees.

There is an option for those who would like to have a plaque at the base of the tree which can be personalized with a four inch by six inch bronze cast plaque. The addition of the plaque is \$250 and includes all material and installation costs. Please note, the Prospect Heights Park District is not responsible for theft, damage or vandalism in the public parks.
