Pool

Cleaning of the pool is completed; work is underway to prepare the shallow section floor and walls for painting. Sun sails and umbrellas were removed and store in the outside pump room, one umbrella will need replacement since material is worn and torn. Pool office was cleaned out and items stored in the shed for the off season. Items stored in the garage for the school season were put in the pool office since there is no room to store these items in gym storage.

Room #2

Ceiling tiles were removed and replaced, cracked light fixture lens were replaced. HVAC vents were cleaned, floors stripped and waxed. Supplies for camp removed and stored in the second floor mechanical room, kinder stop supplies and furniture setup in the room for the being of class.

Gym

East window in the gym facing the parking lot was knocked out of the frame, since the window is Plexiglas's we were able to straighten the frame and reseal the window.

Rear patio

Soil was added to the perimeter of the patio and graded. NRC has started planting along the railing with a variety of plants; these will also be added at the base next to the concession south entry area.

Security

Alarm monitoring was reporting alarms signals from GMRC. Bypassing the Passive Infra detector in the vending area corrected the false alarms; replacement device was ordered and installed.

Inspections

Annual building inspection was completed this month by the Prospect Heights building department. Buses two and three were taken in for the semi-annual test. Bus two had minor light issues that we were able to get the part from Napa and take the bus back the same day for the safety sticker.

Met with Paul Zangara from the baseball league, had samples of the synthetic turf. Plan is to use red clay synthetic turf at home plate and Quick pitch mix for the infield that is also red clay in color. Batter's box will be rebuilt first and grade of the infield to follow.

Muir Park

Both supports for the goal post on the south end of the field rusted out, we removed the goal post and since football is no longer using the field we will not be replacing at this time.

Parks

Late in the season grass is still growing faster than normal, clean up and trimming is still under way at the parks; large tree next to the administration building had to be removed since it was rotting and leaning over the parking lot. We have been trimming the tree in the past but it got to the point it was becoming a safety issue and had to be removed.

Just a quick thank you for bringing me into the PHPD family as a full-time supervisor of recreation! It is good to be home!

KinderStop

The KinderStop program (before and after care) began on August 21, 2018, for the 1st graders. The program has gotten off to a great start!

The AM and PM portion of the program which is for the Kindergarteners began on August 28, 2018.

The pre-school aged children began attending our KinderStop program on September 4, 2018, which is the date that our PHPD Pre-School program began. We are working with four pre-school children who are involved in Early Childhood programs in either District 23 or at Harper College.

The staff is doing a great job working with the kids and enriching their days! For the program the children will be instructed on how to do make their craft/and do their worksheet then have time to work independently, along with free time in the room, in the gym or out at the playground.

We have 140 'seats' filled throughout the program options (Before Care = 30 children; AM KinderStop = 15 children; PM KinderStop = 30 children; and After Care = 65 children). Many of these children fill more that one of these 'seats.' For example, we could have a child in Before Care, AM KinderStop and in After Care. This child fills three seats each day.

The KinderStop program once again received the Power Play grant for school year 2018-2019. The KinderStop program participants will begin participating in a program called "Wifflot" on Wednesdays starting on October 3, 2018.

Kids Day Off

On August 20, 2018, we had a Kids Day Off outing. The 14 participants went to the Enchanted Castle in Lombard. For our upcoming September 19th trip, the group will be going to Richardson's Farm/Corn Maze in Spring Grove. WE will be touring Soldier's Field for our Kids Day Off activity on October 8, 2018 (including enjoying a box lunch in a skybox!).

Aquatics

As the 2018 pool season wrapped up, I had the opportunity to drop in to watch the pool staff in action during the last two weekends of the season. It is my understanding that it

was a challenging summer because of both the weather and because there was a limited number of lifeguards available to work. The guards were great and performed their duties living up to the high level of training they received. They attained the "Exceed" status on all three of the Ellis audits this summer! My job will be to get all of this year's guards to return and then to try to attract more high-quality applicants for the 2019 season. After spending 35 summers (Ronald Reagan was in his first term as President when I came to PHPD!) as the Pool Manager, I am excited about my new role as the Aquatics Supervisor!

Re: General Obligation Limited Tax Park Bonds

There is a requirement to hold a public hearing under the Bond Issue Notification Act (BINA). A public hearing must be held with respect to the issuance of the intent of the Board of Park Commissioners to "sell \$1,900,000 General Obligation Limited Tax Park Bonds for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District and the payment of the expenses incident thereto". This amount will cover the bonds anticipated in 2018, 2019, and 2020.

The "Order" is presented for execution (see attached). The executed original of the Order will be returned to Chapman & Cutler LLP. The Notice of the Hearing was published in the Daily Herald on September 11, 2018 and posted at the Admin building and on the District's website. The original newspaper clipping and certified minutes of the hearing will returned to Chapman & Cutler LLP. The agenda was posted at the Gary Morava Recreation Center and on the District's website.

Speer Financial is responsible for the competitive sale on October 15, 2018. Bond counsel will incorporate the winning bidder's information in the ordinance to be adopted at the October 16th regular Board meeting. Speer Financial will close on October 30th so that he funds are on hand to make the December 1, 2018 payment on the Series 2014B Alternate Bonds.

ORDER calling a public hearing concerning the intent of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Prospect Heights Park District, Cook County, Illinois, to sell \$1,900,000 General Obligation Limited Tax Park Bonds.

WHEREAS, the Prospect Heights Park District, Cook County, Illinois (the "District"), is a duly organized and existing Park District created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois, and is now operating under the provisions of the Park District Code of the State of Illinois, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, including the Local Government Debt Reform Act of the State of Illinois, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the District (the "Board") intends to sell bonds in the amount of \$1,900,000 for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto (the "Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Bond Issue Notification Act of the State of Illinois, as amended, requires the Board to hold a public hearing concerning the Board's intent to sell the Bonds before adopting an ordinance providing for the sale of the Bonds:

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It and It Is Hereby Ordered by the undersigned President of the Board of Park Commissioners of the Prospect Heights Park District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

1. I hereby call a public hearing to be held at 7:00 o'clock P.M. on the 18th day of September, 2018, in the Gary Morava Recreation Center, 110 West Camp McDonald Road, Prospect Heights, Illinois, in the District, concerning the Board's intent to sell the Bonds and to receive public comments regarding the proposal to sell the Bonds (the "Hearing").

- 2. I hereby direct that the Secretary of the Board (the "Secretary") shall (i) publish notice of the Hearing at least once in the Daily Herald, the same being a newspaper of general circulation in the District, not less than 7 nor more than 30 days before the date of the Hearing and (ii) post at least 96 hours before the Hearing a copy of said notice at the principal office of the Board, which notice will be continuously available for public review during the entire 96-hour period preceding the Hearing.
- 3. Notice of the Hearing shall appear above the name of the Secretary and shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING THE INTENT OF THE BOARD OF PARK COMMISSIONERS OF THE PROSPECT HEIGHTS PARK DISTRICT, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS TO SELL \$1,900,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION LIMITED TAX PARK BONDS

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Prospect Heights Park District, Cook County, Illinois (the "District"), will hold a public hearing on the 18th day of September, 2018, at 7:00 o'clock P.M. The hearing will be held in the Gary Morava Recreation Center, 110 West Camp McDonald Road, Prospect Heights, Illinois. The purpose of the hearing will be to receive public comments on the proposal to sell bonds in the amount of \$1,900,000 for the payment of land condemned or purchased for parks, for the building, maintaining, improving and protecting of the same and the existing land and facilities of the District and for the payment of the expenses incident thereto.

At the Hearing, the Board shall explain the reasons for the proposed bond issue and permit persons desiring to be heard an opportunity to present written or oral testimony within reasonable time limits. The Board shall not adopt an ordinance selling the Bonds for a period of seven (7) days after the final adjournment of the Hearing.
