

Administrative / Operational Summary

Executive Director – as submitted. Executive Director Christina Ferraro also reported she attended the Heron Pond Homeowner's Association's annual meeting last night. The association is appreciative of the work provided at the pond by the Park District and Prospect Heights Natural Resource Commission. She also attended a meeting with Chipman Design Architecture Principal, Eagle Scout Sam Sobczak and members of the Natural Resource Commission to discuss the ComEd Green Region Program for Nature Project in Lions Park.

Administrative / Operational Summary (continued)

The architects proposed three bridge concepts. Proposal #1 was chosen. Chipman is compiling costs and will be contacting structural engineers. The project is scheduled for completion in May 2018.

Superintendent of Recreation – as submitted. The Recreation Intern will be starting in May and will be overseen by Supervisor of Recreation Olivia Shapley. The Royal Family Ball special event was held in February at Old Orchard Country Club. The participants enjoyed themselves and the event was successful. Supervisor of Recreation Olivia Shapley informed the Board that she is in the process of hiring the summer aquatics staff.

Superintendent of Facilities and Parks – as submitted. Superintendent of Facilities and Parks Dino Squiers will be holding a final meeting with PHWYBS before the season starts. Staff cannot do anything with the fields at this time due to the rain. Although, the fields are in pretty good shape but needs fill. There was discussion about sending the School District a "thank you" note for the use of equipment.

Approval to award the Comprehensive Master Plan Contract

A request for proposal (RFP) was released to contract a firm to develop a comprehensive master plan for the Park District. The RFP was released to about twenty firms and information was placed on the Park District's website and on NRPA Connect's webpage. Six highly qualified proposals were received by the March 10th proposal submission deadline. Staff reviewed all proposals and chose three to interview based on the cost. The three firms were Design Perspectives, Greenplay LLC and PROs Consulting. The three firms were given the opportunity to present to Staff. After staff discussion and references checked, staff is recommending Greenplay LLC for a cost not to exceed \$55,000. There was lengthy discussion about staff's recommendation.

Heron Pond

The annual home owner association meeting was held in March as previously reported. The annual dues were increased from \$750 to \$1,000 for the pond. This pays the expenses the usual expenses (electricity, aerator pump, and association insurance) and the additional was voted upon to perform the additional maintenance. Marine Biochemists was contacted to apply natural bacteria throughout the summer to the pond in order to dissipate the sediment and add to two additional bubblers. This would make it 4 bubblers in the pond to prevent stagnant water from breeding mosquitoes by aerating it to keep the water gently moving. It adds oxygen to the water and pushes the water up from the bottom of the pond to the surface. It basically helps keep the pond clean and healthy by keeping the water circulating.

ComEd Green Region Program for Nature Project in Lions Park (Resolution 03152016)

We are still waiting for Chipman Design Architecture Principal in Des Plaines to get the District information about the costs from the structural engineers for the bridge design with the steel bottom and wood and cable fencing.

Comprehensive Master Plan

The contract with Greenplay was signed and the District officially began the planning process three weeks ago. Since that time a strategic kick-off meeting was held with District staff, Greenplay, Greenfarrow and RRC; information was gathered for them to review, and several conference calls have taken place to discuss critical success factors. Greenplay consultants will be on-site the week of May 8th to tour facilities and parks, conduct focus groups and hold public input meetings. Focus groups are being planning and stakeholders are being contacted by District staff to participate in the planning process. Marketing the plan will begin now: fliers, website, social media, etc.

Pump Room/Pool

Chemical lines from the tanks, feeder pumps and injectors have been replaced for the pools acid and hydrochloride system. Pumps were disassembled cleaned and the feeder heads rebuilt. Upper and lower injectors in the three main risers were removed to be cleaned and rebuilt.

Dance Room

Door closure on the entrance to the dance room started to leak fluid and lost pressure. Once the piston starts to leak it can't be adjusted and a replacement closure was installed

Tree Inventory

Lou Ennesser former Mt. Prospect superintendent of parks and Prospect heights resident has volunteered to inventory trees in our parks and collect information for future plantings and tree removal. March weather put a temporary halt to the early momentum we enjoyed. We look forward to April with hopes to see better weather and more rounds.

To date we have 56 outings reserved, which is slightly better than last year to date. We are continually working on additional leads with a goal of hitting 100 by year end.

Permanent weekend tee time's sales have continued to decline for another year. In spite of lowering the fees and increasing the playing time allowed we still find it extremely difficult to sell memberships. Current trends in golf and lifestyles have changes and players don't want to lock into permanent upfront payment memberships. We will continue this year selling vacated slots to open play. Once we get to October we will be rolling out an entirely new program offer that will allow foursomes to secure a slot for the 2018 season with a \$400.00 security deposit. This program will provide the golfer with more flexibility and help the club lock in more players. In the event a group can't play on a given weekend they will notify the course that they will be absent. This will give the course a chance to sell the open slot for that weekend day. If the group fails to notify the club prior to Wednesday of the coming weekend the club will charge the permanent tee time holder for the no show by using their deposit of \$400.00 as payment. Two failed calls as no shows will cancel the permanent time for the remainder of the season. This new program should help to increase new permanent time holders for next year. The program will be pay as you go from April 1 to Oct 5 2017. As we near the end of this season more information will follow.

The new carts are running great and being enjoyed by all the players. When the weather has been nice we have enjoyed a packed facility. As we near our peak season we are prepared and ready to be extremely busy. All we need now, (as always) is the weather to cooperate so we can pack the house with tons of golfers.
