The Club House is doing well with the exception to a few new leaks from the roof. Repairs have been made and we will continue monitoring and maintaining to get the most out of the product until we budget for total replacement.

The #2 30-ton AC unit was repaired and is up and running. Now both 30-ton units have new TXV valves which will help prevent Freon leaks and provide better cooling to the facility.

The Golf Course is holding up well and the conditions are much improved from last year's massive turf loss due to excessive rains in 2018. The front of the club house is beautiful as the flower beds have grown and thickened.

We had several banquet events during the month and everyone enjoyed themselves. Great results with food and service continue with every event praising the staff and food.

Staff is doing a great job maintaining a clean and organized facility. The fresh smell in the air awakens you when you enter the facility and helps to start the clients experience on a positive note.

New Halfway Stop is now open with walkway path installed. Golfers now can stop for a quick bite or drink at the 9<sup>th</sup> hole. This new process is working out well and also saving on additional labor Monday through Thursday.

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# Prospect Heights Park District ORDINANCE 07.23.19

# AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY OF THE PROSPECT HEIGHTS PARK DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, the Prospect Heights Park District, Cook County, Illinois ("Park District") owns personal property as described in Addendum A. hereinafter known as the "Property," and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 8-22 of the Park District Code (70 ILCS 1205/8-22) ("Code"), the Park District is authorized to sell, convey or donate any personal property that in the opinion of three-fifths of the members of the Board of Park Commissioners then holding office is no longer necessary, useful to, or for the best interests of the Park District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Park Commissioners ("Board") has determined that it would be in the best interest of the Park District to dispose of said Property described in Addendum A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Park Commissioners of the Prospect Heights Park District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Board finds that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true and correct and does hereby incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

**Section 2.** The Board finds that the Property is no longer necessary and useful to the Park District and declares it to be for the best interests of the Park District and its residents to dispose of the Property

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and in effect from and after its adoption as provided by law.
