

WHAT IS A KID CARD?

The Kid Card works like a debit card and can be used in our concessions stand as payment if there are funds available on their card. Parents can load and check the balance of their campers Kid Card in their online account at www.phparks.org or at our Front Desk. Each Kid Card will have the camper's name, picture, and household id number. The first card is free, however, if lost there is a \$5 charge for a replacement card.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Campers must be present when signing up for the Kid Card so a picture can be taken. You can begin taking pictures for your Kid Card beginning May 1st. Cards will be handed out during the first week of camp. For additional Kid Card sign ups after Open House, please allow 2 business days for your camper to receive their card. We will start accepting the Kid Card for payment on Wednesday, June 7th. Be sure to send money for Monday & Tuesday if you would like your camper to purchase anything from the Concessions Stand.

HOW A PARENT CAN ADD MONEY TO A KID CARD ONLINE

Step 1: Go to www.phparks.org

Step 2: Click on the Registration button at top of home page

Step 3: Sign into your household account

Step 4: Click on My Account

Step 5: Under History & Balances, click on Add Credit

Step 6: Under Credit Restriction use the drop-down arrow to

highlight CONCESSIONS CREDIT

Step 7: Enter desired amount of credit, then add to cart

Step 8: Click Proceed to Checkout to finish the transaction

Follow steps 1-5 Click on My History to see items purchased

HOW TO CHECK YOUR BALANCE

Go to www.phparks.org

Click on the Registration button at top of home page.

Sign into your household account

Click on My Account

Under History & Balances, click on Household Balance

It will show any Concessions Credit you have on your account.

It is the parents' responsibility to check their campers kid card account for low balance.
