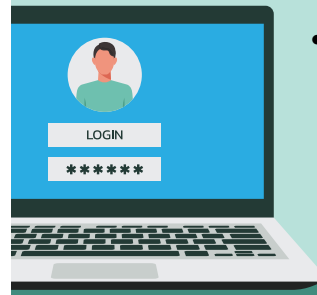

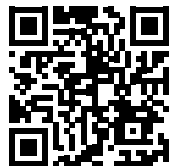

OUT OF DISTRICT FAIR SHARE FEES

The Prospect Heights Park District residents make a significant contribution to the financing and operations of the park district through their property taxes. This contribution is beyond the fees they pay for programs and services. The fair share fee was adopted by the park district's Board of Commissioners to equalize this financial burden. For select programs, the fair share fees will be 15% more than the park district resident fee for non-residents.

Therefore, the Prospect Heights Park District is not responsible for loss of personal property or participation in recreation programs.

WHO IS A PROSPECT HEIGHTS PARK DISTRICT RESIDENT?

You are a resident if you pay taxes to the Prospect Heights Park District.

PARTNER RESIDENT AGREEMENTS

Through our cooperative "three-for-one" agreement, all programs and most facilities offered by the three listed park districts are available to anyone living within each of the three park district boundaries. A resident of any of the three districts is considered a Partner Resident of the other two park districts and is therefore able to enroll in classes or programs at resident rates. Each of the park district golf courses will have a Partner Resident fee available on weekdays only. Although the agreement may result in an increase in the number of potential users, each park district will continue to maintain its individual identity and utilize monies available to it at present tax rates. Residents always receive priority registration within their "home district" while enjoying the added benefit of enrolling in a "partner district's" class or program at resident rates.

PARTNER RESIDENT AGREEMENT WITH SCHOOL DISTRICT 23

The Prospect Heights Park District and School District 23 entered into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement to save the taxpayers money by sharing the use of properties owned by District 23 and the Prospect Heights Park District in a manner that the facilities may be utilized to their fullest capacity. Part of this agreement includes that all inhabitants who reside within School District 23 boundaries shall be considered partner residents and will not be required to pay non-resident fees.

REFUND POLICY

A refund may be requested by completing the Refund Request Form at <https://phparks.org/refund-request-form>. A full refund will be issued if the program is cancelled by the Park District. Prior to the commencement of the program, refunds are given except for uniforms or supplies pre-purchased. Prorated refunds may be received for medical reasons and extenuating circumstances only with the supervisor's approval. Allow 10-15 business days for processing. No cash refunds. No refunds are given for deposits, passes, contractual programs, leagues, trips, unused activities or specials events before or after the activity unless cancelled by the Park District.

HOW TO CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT

Everyone must have a **Customer Account to register for programs**. For Prospect Heights residents and Partner residents, you need to prove residency to get the resident rate. Please check on cookcountyviewer.com. Enter your address. If your park district taxes go to Prospect Heights, you are a Resident. If your taxes go to Mt. Prospect Park District, River Trail Park District or School District 23, you are a Partner Resident. Partner Residents receive the resident rate on the non-resident registration date.

If you are a resident or a partner resident: Visit us during our open hours of operation to make a customer account. You must bring proof of residency for you and your family members with the current address listed.

Adults can bring a driver's license, state ID, or one of the following: utility bill (no older than 60 days), voter registration card, or a vehicle registration card.

Children will need to show one of these: a birth certificate, parent insurance card listing dependents, current report card, school picture ID, or other form of ID a parent may have that proves the children reside at that address.

If you are a non-resident: Call 847.394.2848 to have your account set up during open hours of operation. No proof of residency is required. You will be required to give your name, address, email, phone number and date of birth.
